Welcome to the 23rd Annual Cuyuna Agate & Mineral Show, which will take place on May 9th and 10th, 2026.

Registration does not guarantee your space; there will be some jurying of vendors. We prefer rock dealers or artisans over resellers of foreign goods. You will be notified by email or phone (call/text) if you have been accepted or are on the waiting list. If you do not get accepted your fee will be refunded.

If you have a special collection you would be willing to share in one of our display cases, please reserve on the registration form.

The Cuyuna Rock, Gem, and Mineral Society will again be offering a free Friday night vendor soup and sandwich buffet. Please indicate on the registration, to the best of your knowledge, how many people will be attending the buffet. We plan on having a speaker after the meal.

We will be publishing a vendor list and floor map. Vendors are able to purchase ad space in the program. There is an upload field on the form for advertising. Mailed in registration must provide a business card or camera ready ad.

There will be no sharing of spaces, inside or outside. One vendor/business per registered space. No smoking or alcohol on the premises; no dogs, except for service dogs; no firearms allowed. (Crow Wing County Fairgrounds rules.) There will be no trimming of trees, bushes, or shrubs. No incense, candle burning, or similar inside the buildings. If your vehicle is part of your outside booth, you may park in your booth, otherwise all vehicles must be parked north of the Curling Club or in the south parking lot.

Indoor Spaces

Indoor tables will be \$85 per 8' table (provided). Spacing will remain similar to 2025; we plan on using two buildings. Space location will be assigned at our discretion. Because there was some table damage last year, tables will be checked with vendors before the sale, and inspected before leaving on Sunday. Vendors are responsible for damage. If you are an indoor vendor, please initial here to indicate that you have read and agreed with this.

Tailgate Spaces:

Tailgate space will be \$55 per 15 feet of frontage for the weekend (space only). Spaces on corners have frontage on two sides and are charged for frontage on each side. (\$110 total) Please indicate a corner space in the registration form, if desired. There will be no last minute registrations for tailgaters at the gate on Saturday. All tailgate spaces will be presold and assigned at our discretion, and availability.

Please complete and return your registration forms by March 1, 2026.

Registration after March 1st will be charged a \$25 late fee and are not guaranteed a space.

Move in: 2:00 - 8:00 p.m. Friday May $8 \sim$ Move out: Sunday May 10 after 4:00 p.m. Leaving prior to show ending time is not acceptable; you may not be asked to vend at the 2027 show.
